
Ventral view of elbow section of right wing (Rock dove, Columba livia).



Site of venipuncture (obscured by feathers)

Wing held out b/w index and middle finger.

Throat aligned with gap between index and middle fingers to avoid choking.

Approximate site where a finger could be placed (or move the thumb up) to create back pressure on the vein proximal to the puncture site, increasing flow rate.

Belly & feet to palm
